

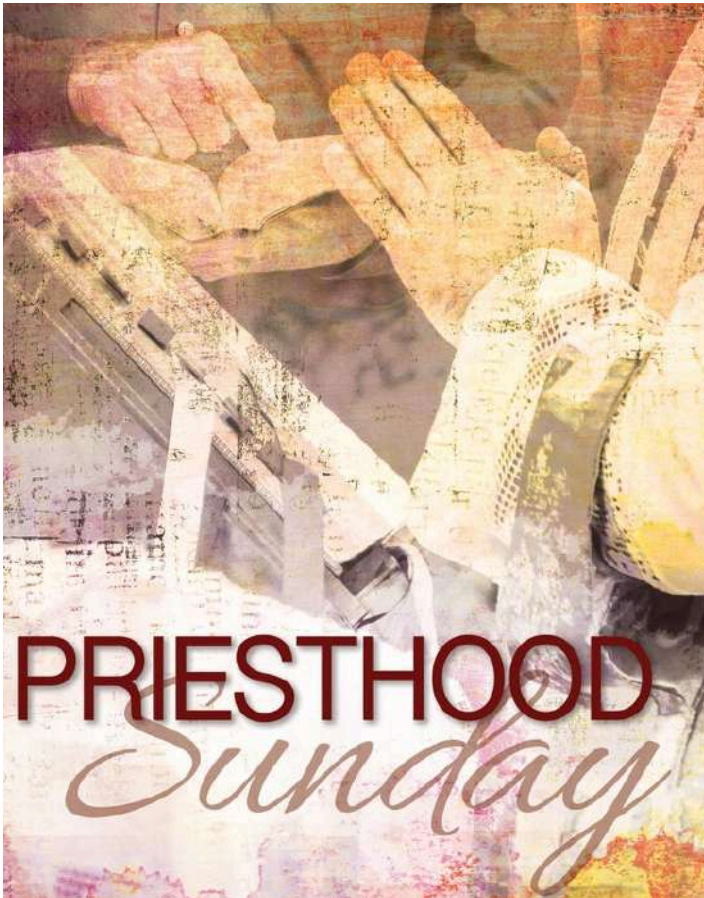

## Reflections on Readings for the Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

***"Would That All The People Of The Lord Were Prophets"***

Our readings this Sunday remind us that the Holy Spirit blows wherever it wishes. The community of God's people is not an exclusive club where only the in-crowd is recognized.



We also hear Jesus teaching on the gravity of sin. A central theme of Jesus's teaching is the desire that every soul enter into the Kingdom of Heaven and eternal union with God, as apposed to the opposite (Gehenna). ([CCC 1033-1037](#)).

**In our first reading** ([Numbers 11:25-29](#)), we hear of 70 elders upon whom the Spirit had descended to assist Moses in his mission. When Joshua discovered that two others had also received the Spirit, he was jealous. Moses set him straight. "Moses answered him, 'Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets! Would that the LORD might bestow His spirit on them all!'"

**In our Epistle reading** ([James 5:1-6](#)), St. James calls out a warning to those whose ill-gotten wealth came at the expense of others and to those who use their wealth to fatten themselves instead of sharing their wealth with those less fortunate and working for a more equitable society.

**Our Gospel reading** ([Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48](#)) echoes our first reading wherein the young apostle John was indignant that someone not of their group would dare to exorcise demons in the name of Jesus. "Do not prevent him", Jesus said. The Spirit was at work in this person even though he was not in full communion with the disciples. Jesus also warned about the gravity of sin, teaching that we must root out whatever evil is preventing us from being in right relationship with God and entering into the Kingdom of Heaven.

Whether it be the wealthy or the members of the "in-crowd", those who see their membership in the body of Christ as an exclusive club have been put on notice. God's wealth and God's Spirit is to be shared with everyone, especially the lowest, the poorest, and the weakest - "these little ones", as Jesus called them. Our blessings, whatever they may be, are meant to be shared. If anything in our life is separating us from God, we must root it out and cut it off.
